



Deriving its name from the mathematical concept, the shape comprises two horizontal, parallel table tops supported by a perpendicular construction of parallel lines. This creates a harmonious cross pattern beautifully complemented by rounded edges. Resulting in a visually light and graphical expression.

Parallel sofabordet er inspireret af de glasmontrer, man finder på museer. Ved at udnytte glassets egenskab eksperimenterer bordet med at bringe små kuraterede gallerier ind i hjemmet. En inspiration der fremhæves i det skabte rum mellem de horisontale flader, der fungerer som en æstetisk udstillingsplads for bøger og dekorative genstande i stuen.

Formen, der har fået sit navn fra det matematiske koncept, består af to horisontale, parallelle bordplader understøttet af en egetræskonstruktion af parallelle linjer. Dette skaber et harmonisk krydsmønster, smukt komplementeret af afrundede kanter, hvilket giver et visuelt let og grafisk udtryk.
